## **Key District Notices**

- <u>Communications Changes</u>: In a poll of Mission Peak Scouters this summer, three key requests was for better communications.
  - <u>A regular Newsletter</u> Our target is to publish monthly starting with this edition.
  - A dedicated Mission Peak Website Using the SFBAC.org site did not allow as much district specific information as desired. Hence, we have launched <a href="https://MissionPeakScouts.com">https://MissionPeakScouts.com</a>. This will be the home for information related to Mission Peak and Mission Peak specific events.
  - Better Email system The old Yahoo group had difficulty in signing up and recent changes in the Yahoo group policies dictated a better system. The new Google group for Mission Peak is:

- Arrow of Light Scout Bridging: In the next 3 to 4 months, most of the Webelos II Scouts will bridge over to Scouts BSA. Three critical things need to happen:
  - 1. The Webelos must find a unit that matches them. Contact us if you are having issues.
  - The Advancement Records for the Arrow of Light Scouts MUST be recorded by National BEFORE the youth is registered in the Scouts BSA Unit. This is critical! As soon as the youth is registered in the Scouts BSA unit, it is no longer possible to record the Arrow of Light with National.

- 3. The Cub Pack is responsible for collecting the PAIA fee for all youth registered with the Pack as of January 1, 2020, including the Webelos who are about to bridge. It is strongly advised that the Pack collects the PAIA fee for the Webelos before they are allowed to bridge into Scouts BSA.
- Re-charter Reminders: By this point, all units should be fairly well along on their re-charter. As a reminder, ALL registered adults must fill out a BSA Waiver for a periodic background check. Click here to download the current form. The signed wafers are to be turned in at re-charter.
