

## **Key District Notices**

- <u>Arrow of Light Scout Bridging:</u> In the next few weeks, most of the Webelos II Scouts will bridge over to Scouts BSA. Three critical things need to happen:
  - 1. The Webelos must find a unit that matches them. <u>Contact us</u> if you are having issues.
  - The <u>Advancement Records for the Arrow</u> of Light Scouts MUST be reported by the PACK to National **BEFORE** the youth is registered in the Scouts BSA Unit.
  - **3.** The Cub Pack is responsible for collecting the PAIA fee for all youth registered with the Pack as of January 1, 2020, including the Webelos who are bridging. It is strongly advised that the Pack collects the PAIA fee for the Webelos before they are allowed to bridge into Scouts BSA.
